The Electronic Guard Force Never Sleeps: The Role of Residential Alarms

At a time of heightened threats and tight resources, residential alarm systems go a long way toward a comprehensive security program.

AES alarms are sold in “kits” – sensible ensembles of alarm sensors and accessories, packaged for small, medium and large installations.

What’s New: Super-Duty Power Supplies for AES 5100 Alarms

AES has upgraded the power supply to address the many power problems surfacing around the world. These problems include power surges, low voltage brownouts, and even over-voltages that create havoc for all types of electrical equipment.

Of course, the backup battery in the alarm panel keeps the system up during power failures, but the device is still connected to the troublesome local AC mains. To overcome the problems, all AES 5100 alarm panels and kits now include a super-duty power supply, our part number 720-18 (previously sold only as an upgrade). This rugged supply enables the alarm system to run on 90 to 260 volts, 45-70 cycles, and everything in between. And if the power exceeds those boundaries, the power supply isolates itself - and the alarm system - from the problem.
